
Thírd Sunday of Lent March 19, 2017

First Reading: Exodus 17:3-7; Responsorial Psalm 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9 Second Reading: Romans 5:1-2,5-8; Gospel: John 4:5-42

"If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." — Psalm 95



We are told that after her encounter with Jesus, the Samaritan woman left everything—including her water jar—and went into the town to share her experience: "Come see a man who told me everything I have done. Could he possibly be the Christ?" May our Lenten experience enable us to encounter Jesus with the Samaritan woman's hope and joy so that we, too, might become intensely engaged and actively involved in conversation and service with Our Lord. He also knows us intimately and wants more than anything to quench our thirst: "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again; but whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him/her a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

May our Lenten desert journey with Jesus lead us anew to the

waters of baptism and the renewal of our Baptismal Promises. And may our hearts be filled with faith and joy as we proclaim with the crowd: "We know that this is truly the savior of the world."
