So often, like the disciples on their way home to Emmaus, our lives are shattered with despair and disappointments. Things don't work out the way we expect. Often we feel as if God has let us down. Our beautiful story from Luke's Gospel reminds us, however, that Our Lord is always at our side. He even speaks to us through the gift of scripture, prayer, and the faithful, caring "stranger" walking with us. When we recognize Him our hearts burn with joy!

After being fed by His word, the disciples invite the stranger at their side to stay with them. He agrees. "And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them." And with that they recognized Him! They recognized the Risen Jesus in the breaking of the bread. And they quickly returned to Jerusalem to share the Good News with the other disciples! We, too, recognize our Lord in the breaking of the bread. He shows us the path of life and leads us to a life filled with His presence. A Eucharistic life of love and unity that raises us up and frees us from all despair!


