
# The Ascension of the Lord May 28, 2017

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11; Responsorial Psalm 47:2-3, 6-9 Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23; Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

# "WHY ARE YOU STANDING THERE LOOKING AT THE SKY?"



The men from Galilee received this question from the two angels of God in the Acts of the Apostles. Like us, they are urged to not just *look*, but rather to actively *respond* to our Lord's Ascension into Heaven! Jesus, in Matthew's Gospel, tells us: **"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations..."** He commands that we not be passive observers, but rather active participants in the building of God's Reign of love and peace. Actively living our faith and bringing the joy of the Gospel into the world means that we not only take seriously and live our discipleship, but that we also call forth others. We witness our faith.

The beautiful and inspiring words of Paul in the letter to the Ephesians challenge us to live our faith more fully: "May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened, that you may know the hope that belongs to His call, what are the riches of glory in His inheritance among the holy ones, and what is the surpassing greatness of His power for us who believe..." Let us always remember that in Baptism we are called and sent by the Lord. "I am with you always, until the end of the age," the ascended Jesus promises us. Witnesses we are. We let the Holy Spirit blow through our lives and into our world! ALLELUIA!

Fill our lives with wonder and awe in your presence which penetrates all creation. Come Holy Spirit, Come!


