First Reading: Jeremiah 20:10-13 14b-16a;
Responsorial Psalm: 69:8-10, 14, 17, 33-35
Second Reading: Romans 5:12-15; Gospel: Matthew 10:26-33

Let us strive to openly proclaim the Gospel message with joyful hearts.

Each of us is called to testify to the spirit of truth that is Jesus. When we give faithful witness, we hear in today's Gospel, Jesus says he will acknowledge us before the Father. Let us not be afraid to testify to our belief in Jesus.

The prophet Jeremiah reminds his listeners that he lives under constant threat from outsiders, but he is confident the Lord is with him. Saint Paul reminds the Romans that Adam brought sin and death into the world, but Jesus' sacrificial act brought new life and a new creation. In Matthew's Gospel, Christ reminds his disciples to remain steadfast in their witness to the truth.

The July 1 deadline for applying for the 2017 scholarships is quickly approaching! Applicants are invited to visit the Parish Office or our website for the **2017 Application Form**. Applications must complete to be considered.

Requirements are as follows:

1. Applicants must be active parishioners of OLMC. Applicants must have been accepted or enrolled in an accredited college or university, junior college, vocational or trade school as a full-time students.
2. A written statement describing your background, educational goals, participation in the parish, and how you will benefit from the scholarship.
3. A copy of your diploma verifying your H.S. graduation or GED equivalency certificate, as well as a copy of your school letter of acceptance, must be included.
4. At least one letter of recommendation.

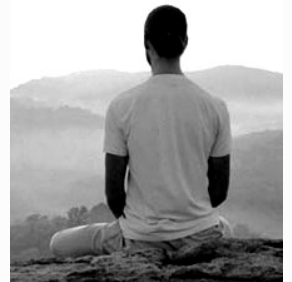


Offering a Mass
