Sacred Community

St. Paul's words today are especially challenging: "Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law." Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew urges us to do all that is possible as individuals and as a community of believers to bring

healing and peace to our relationships and world. This requires respect and understanding, as well as sharing our stories and opening our hearts.

Our Lord reminds us that as we gather in faith and love, He is with us: "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." These words of Jesus bring us back to the true sense of being part of a *sacred community* where we gather around Jesus and ask Him how we are to follow Him. We are created to live in community and welcome others—to keep our eyes on Jesus and to exclude no one. For He is among us! Thanks be to God.


