Thirty-Second Sunday of Ordinary Time

November 12, 2017

First Reading: Wisdom 6:12-16; Responsorial Psalm 63:2-8; Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; Gospel: Matthew 25:1-13

"My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God."

The virgins in the parable of Jesus this Sunday are either wise or foolish. The wise are ready and prepared for the Lord or *Bridegroom*. They have sufficient oil for their lamps. Whereas the foolish demonstrate their lack of preparedness for the coming of the Bridegroom by not having sufficient oil. The parable reminds us of the importance of being prepared for the Wedding Feast—the banquet of God's eternal Reign of Love!

The Book of Wisdom urges us to prepare ourselves for the Lord by seeking God with love: "Resplendent and unfading is wisdom, and she is readily perceived by those who love her, and found by those who seek her." And as St. Paul tells us in his First Letter to the Thessalonians, our vigilance is nourished by hope. Eternal life—the Banquet of the Bridegroom—starts here and now; otherwise it would not be eternal. In Paul's words: "Thus we shall always be with the Lord. Therefore console one another with these words." May we be among the wise, carrying in our hearts an abundance of oil, and serving God and neighbor with hearts set aflame with passionate love. With the Psalmist we pray: "Thus will I bless you while I live; lifting up my hands, I will call upon your name!"

Most of all, we thank you for Jesus, your Son and our Redeemer, who came among us to show us the way to eternal life. May the offering of our time, our talents, and our material resources be made in the same spirit of sacrifice that Jesus taught us by his life and death for us. May our faithful stewardship bear witness to the love of Christ in our lives. We pray this with grateful hearts in Jesus' name. Amen.
