
Our Lord Jesus Chríst, Kíng of the Uníverse November 26, 2017



First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17; Resp. Psalm 23:1-2, 2-3, 5-6; Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:20-27, 28; Gospel: Matthew 25:31-46

"Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world."

These words of Jesus are meant for each one of us. As baptized, we have been called to share in the reign of Christ the King. Not a reign

of power and authority, according to earthly standards, but a reign of compassion, love and justice, according to the standards of Jesus, the only one who counts! Jesus is our Shepherd King who provides for our needs and shows us the way home to the Father. The path is provided for us as he prepares to enter into his passion, death and resurrection. He asks that we love and serve him, by loving and serving the least among us. Actually, he goes ever farther by telling us that whatever we do or don't do for the least among us—the hungry and thirsty, the stranger (the migrant and refugee), the naked, the ill or incarcerated—we do or don't do for Jesus himself. He identifies himself completely with those at the margins of society. As we care for them, we care for our Lord himself.

The Solemnity of the King of the Universe sums up what is required of us as disciples, a royal people: faithful and unconditional love and service. And he promises us: *"Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world."*


