"What are you looking for?"

We are told in this first chapter of John's Gospel that Jesus turned to Andrew and the other disciple of John the Baptist and asked them this very important question. I believe that it is very likely that John intends this other disciple to be each of us. "Where are you staying?" they respond to Jesus. Another translation might be, "Where do you dwell or abide?" And Jesus urges them, "Come, and you will see." Before we know it, Andrew is calling out to Simon Peter, his brother, "We have found the Messiah!" Andrew found what he was looking for and with joy wants to share this good news with his brother. Their lives were changed forever!

We, too, are called to manifest or reveal our Lord to others. Jesus asks us to dwell with him. Each one of us is meant to be the nameless disciple accompanying Andrew. Let's open our lives to his love. Only then will we be able to say with joy, "Hear I am Lord, I come to do your will."


