"Teach me your ways, O Lord."

Psalm 25 is a beautiful prayer which reflects our own identity and mission as people of God. This is what Jesus is teaching us in the Gospel. He summons us to a new way of life—a new way of living! This happens give generously of ourselves through our compassionate service to God's Reign as followers of Jesus. "Your ways, O Lord, make known to me; teach me your paths, guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God, my savior."
