“What is this? A new teaching with authority.”

Mark tells us, “The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority.” It was clear to those who came to know Jesus that he taught with the authority of his words and actions. “He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him.” Jesus lived as he taught and was always in communion with the Father’s love. He teaches us what is required to be a disciple: compassionate and liberating actions.

Like Jesus, we are called to live as a powerful sign of God’s love, present and active within and through our faith, as the Body of Christ. 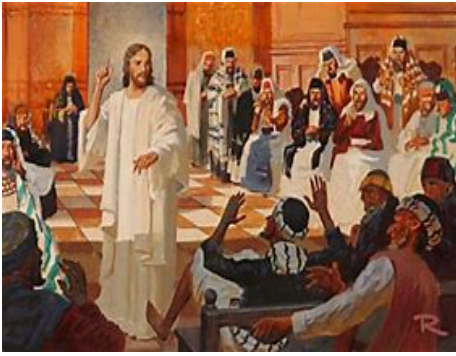
