"Zeal for your house will consume me."

The gospel passage that we hear this Sunday expresses the zeal that Jesus had for the Father's house. Love for human beings made in the image and likeness of God was the focus of Jesus' life and mission. He clearly understood worship as being in communion with the Father's will and caring for one another. Our rituals are to reveal our love for God and commitment to living a life of giving and serving which reflects the Heart of Jesus. It is a love that is lived in service of one another and especially the most vulnerable. This is why Jesus was so passionate and angry about the money changers and injustices that he encountered in the temple. "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace."

We are invited this Third Sunday of Lent to pray for the zeal that consumed Jesus to consume our lives. May the heart of Jesus lead us to live faithfully and passionately our commitment to protect and care for others.

Compassionate Support for Dreamers

In response to the Supreme Court decision, Bishop Joe S. Vásquez of Austin, Chairman of the Committee on Migration, stated: "Monday's Supreme Court decision does not reduce the urgency of finding an immediate legislative solution for Dreamers, people who were brought to the United States as children and have known only our country as their home. The anxiety and uncertainty that Dreamers and their families face remain unabated. Monday was our National Callin Day for Dreamers, when thousands of Catholics urged their leaders in Congress to protect Dreamers. These faithful took action because they recognize that protecting these young people from deportation is an issue of human life and dignity, and that a legislative solution is necessary to make that protection durable. My brother Bishops and I continue to call upon Congress to work towards a bipartisan and humane solution as soon as possible."


