#### "You are my friends if you do what I command you."

Saints, those who live in the holiness of God, have from early times been called *friends of God*. They are individuals who reveal God's presence through the gift of their love. Jesus calls us today to be his friends. He tells us that he has chosen and appointed us personally to bear fruit. We bear this fruit through our love. "This I command you: love one another." Our love for others manifests God and identifies us as his beloved friends.

Pope Francis urges us in his Apostolic Exhortation *On The Call to Holiness in Today's World:* "Do not be afraid of holiness. It will take away none of your energy, vitality or joy. On the contrary, you will become what the Father had in mind when he created you, and you will be faithful to your deepest self." Being friends of God unites us intimately with the Risen Jesus. Like Peter in Acts, we are empowered with the Spirit to live with a heart that welcomes and includes everyone. John tells us, "Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love." Living in his love offers us a life now and forever as *friends of God*!

5. Provide at least one letter of recommendation from a counselor, teacher or employer.
