"Go therefore, and make disciples..."

How interesting that our celebration of the Most Holy Trinity should call us to "make disciples." The central theme of Matthew's gospel and the final words of Jesus urge us to follow him. Disciples of Jesus are not isolated. Faith is lived in community—a God centered community. This community of the Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, is a community of infinite love. As Moses in the Book of Deuteronomy, "This is why you must now know, and fix in your heart, that the Lord is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other."

St. Augustine refers to the Most Holy Trinity as Lover, Beloved, and Love. A relational God that transforms us with love and enables us to live as witnesses of all that we are and all that we have received as children of God. We live in faith, hope and love, trusting in the promise and final words of Jesus in Matthew's Gospel: "I am with you always, until the end of the age."


