“This is my body...This is my blood...”

We gather at the table of the Lord and celebrate the most sacred gift of the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ. We prayerfully proclaim our faith as followers of Jesus. Our lives are changed forever. The passionate story of Jesus’ love given without counting the cost becomes ours. When we gather at His table we do so as a sign of our commitment to a life as Jesus lived here on earth. And he continues to live and act— through us—with love and mercy.

Mass is the Latin word for *mission*. We are united through the Body and Blood of Christ in one global faith, one Lord. We become what we receive. We recognize that we belong to something larger than ourselves. We belong to Christ. His blood flows within us. We become family with the Most Holy Trinity and with sisters and brothers throughout the globe. We are sent on mission: “Do this in memory of me,” he tells us. As he has given his body and blood for us, so we should give our body and blood for others—in his memory. That’s our mission: to be sent out from here bearing gifts of faith, hope, and love.

5. Provide at least one letter of recommendation from a counselor, teacher or employer.
