First Reading: Genesis 3:9-15; Psalm 130:1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8;
Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1; Gospel: Mark 3:20-35

“Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother.”

The loving and compassionate heart of Jesus—His Most Sacred Heart—brings healing and hope to those who are hurting and in desperate need of wholeness and peace. While the will of God consumes Jesus, scribes come from Jerusalem saying that he is *possessed* by evil. They want the people to believe that Jesus’ power to heal comes from Satan. But Jesus makes it very clear that his love—his power to heal—comes from God. It is God’s will and authority that are alive and active in his Most Sacred Heart.

Jesus tells us that doing the will of God makes us family of God. “Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother.” God’s will is that those who suffer receive compassion, love and wholeness. This is what the crowds receive from Jesus. And this is what we, too, receive and share through the gift of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. As family of God, God’s love flows through us to bring hope, healing and peace to our world!
