"I say to you, arise!"

The Book of Wisdom beautifully reminds us that our God is a God of Life, not death: "God did not make death, nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living. For he fashioned all things that they might have being..." All of us are from God. And Jesus, in today's gospel, shows us that God brings life, healing and wholeness to those who place their faith in him. Large crowds gathered as he went "to the other side"—where the desperate and marginalized are found.

Jesus brings hope and new life to the suffering. Jairus, the synagogue official, and the woman who had suffered with hemorrhages for twelve years are both gifted with healing and new life because of their faith in the Lord. Jairus is told, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." The infirmed woman, too, reminds us that it is our faith that saves us. Like the young daughter of Jairus, we are called by Jesus to "arise!" Together, with him, we "arise" to new life for ourselves and for those desperately in need of our love, healing and hope.
