

"Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while."

Without a doubt, Jesus is concerned about our health and wellbeing. We recall his words to the apostles—and to us, "Come away..." He knows us intimately and recognizes that we need to be with him for moments "away" for rest. Only then can we respond to the many needs that call out to us.

Summer is a special time for renewal of body and spirit. The warmth of these days and the challenges of life call to mind words of Thomas Merton: "As a magnifying glass concentrates the rays of the sun into a little burning knot of heat that can set fire to a dry leaf or a piece of paper, so the mysteries of Christ in the Gospel concentrate the rays of God's light and fire to a point that sets fire to the spirit of man." Let us allow ourselves to rest in Jesus so the warmth of his healing rays may refresh and renew us as loving disciples.

Mark tells us, "His heart was moved with pity..." The compassion of Jesus calls out to us. Psalm 23 speaks to our hearts today, "The Lord is my shepherd...beside restful waters he leads me; he refreshes my soul."

Pastoral Letter: The Eucharistic Communion Procession and Reception of Holy Communion

This Pastoral Letter has come together at the direction of Bishop Garcia. With the encouragement of the Presbyteral Council the writing of the Pastoral began in 2017. It was Bishop Garcia's hope that all of us, in each parish community, would celebrate the beauty of the Eucharist with one mind and heart, mindful that we belong to the local church in our Diocese of Monterey. Faith Formation Classes and Registration


Youth Corner (Mark 6:30-34)
