"There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish..."

With the Lord among us, nothing is impossible! The five loaves and two fish offered by a generous boy feeds more than 5000 people. Not only does everyone have enough to eat, but there are twelve wicker baskets with fragments of bread left over! The compassionate heart of Jesus changes the limited gifts of bread and fish to feed the hungry—with food left over.

The Gospel passages for this Sunday and the next four Sundays focus on chapter 6 of John's account of the Gospel, known as the Bread of Life discourse. The miracle today is the only one that appears in all four gospels. We are reminded of God's transforming power present with us in the Eucharist. As we gather with the Lord at his table, the boy's faith in Jesus is an example of what we are invited to receive in faith. When we give Jesus all that we are, he reveals his presence and power. And by loving others as he loves us, giving of ourselves for others, we make Jesus' mission our own. Our psalm reminds us, "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs."

Faith Formation Classes and Registration

Registration for our first year classes for the Sacraments of the Eucharist (First Communion) and Reconciliation are taking place. Registration forms are available in the parish office during the week or by speaking with Fr. Dennis following Mass. Children must be at least in the 2nd grade, attend the 9 am Sunday Mass, and attend the class that follows.

Registration is also taking place for the **Sacrament** of **Confirmation** for High School students. There will also be **Classes for adults who are baptized** and would like to prepare for other Sacraments of the Eucharist, Reconciliation and Confirmation. Preparation for the **Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)** is for those adults who are would like to be baptized as members of our Catholic Church. For more information speak with Fr. Planning for our new restrooms, ADA requirements, kitchen and parish center to meet the diverse ministry needs of our parish continues to move forward! A floor plan has been accepted by our Site Committee and our architect is now developing the next level of detail.

Our Capital Campaign Committee is working to establish a financial plan to support the project. As a first step in the financial plan, Our Sunday Visitor, a Catholic non-profit organization, will conduct a Feasibility Study beginning in September to evaluate our ability to support this transformative project for our Parish. 


Youth Corner (John 6:1-15)
