

"The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

Jesus tells us this Sunday that he gives us himself as food "for the life of the world." In other words, the bread of life that we receive is to give life—the life of Jesus—to the world. Our relationship with the Lord is not limited to our personal relationship, but rather it sustains and empowers us to become what we eat—the Body of Christ. We become what we eat and together we are the Bread of Life for others, as Jesus' Word and Flesh is for us!

We are invited today to reflect upon and seek to live with the Heart of Jesus for the life of the world. Jesus urges us to go forth into the world to draw others to look at their deepest hungers and guide them to God's love. As Paul tells us, "Be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ." It is difficult to comprehend God's gracious love, but it is through the Body and Blood of Jesus that we are gifted with the opportunity to "be imitators of God" honoring and reverencing God in one another. As Psalm 34 tells us: "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord!"


## Youth Corner (John 6:41-51)


