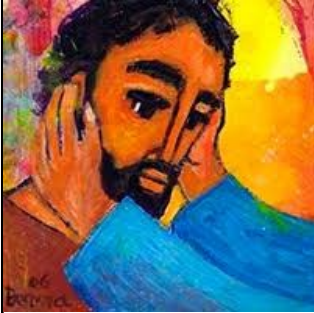

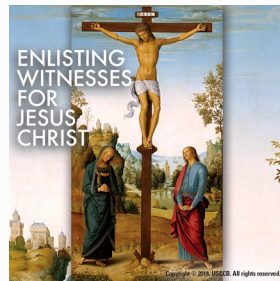
Catechetical Sunday 2018

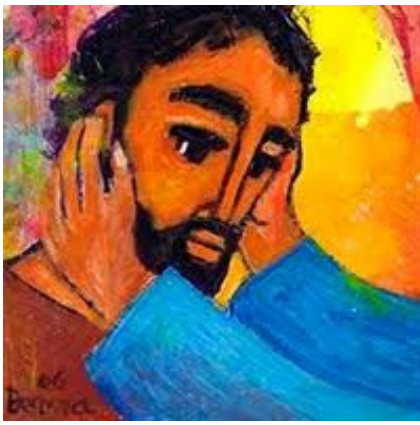
