"Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me..."

The disciples were arguing on the way about who was the greatest. Jesus placed a child before them and putting his arms around the child, tells them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and who receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me." Jesus makes it clear that "greatness" in God's kingdom comes from being "the last of all and the servant of all." St. Teresa of Avila tells us, "Imagine yourself to be the servant of all, and look upon all as if they were Christ our Lord in person. And thus shall you do him honor and reverence."

To receive "the child," the most vulnerable, the weak, and the poor in need of our care and protection is to welcome them so that they know they are loved and treasured. It has often been said that the moral test of a society is how the poor, the weak, and the vulnerable are treated. The Book of Wisdom reminds us that evil tries to silence justice. However, James urges us, "the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace." As followers of Jesus, can we help bring about a world in which every child is safe?

Capital Campaign Feasibility Study

During the past few years our parish has been involved in a process of study and discernment for the updating of our facilities to meet ADA requirements and the needs of our parish. Your input has been extremely important in this process.

We are trying to limit the scope of our building project to a budget of \$1.5 million. We hope that this will be possible, but to be certain that we have the required support to move forward with a Capital Campaign, we will be asking your input during the month of October with a Feasibility Study. The study will be conducted by *Our Sunday Visitor*, a Catholic non-profit organization that specializes in small Capital Campaigns. The process will provide us with the necessary information to assure that we have the potential for a successful Capital Campaign to meet the financial needs of this important project.

Our goal will be to reach all of our parishioners for your opinion. In the next couple of weeks, members of our committee will be telephoning some of you to schedule a phone interview with our Consultant from *Our Sunday Visitor*.

Who will participate in this study? Every parishioner who attends Mass, as well as all registered parishioners, will be asked to offer your counsel and opinion.

How will the study be conducted? The study will be conducted through the use of two important methods: in depth personal phone interviews and an in-pew survey on the weekend of October 13 and 14.

Who will be interviewed? A cross section of individuals have been selected to participate in the interview process. The interviews should last no more than 30 minutes and will be conducted by phone by a Consultant from *Our Sunday Visitor*.

What will happen to the study results? Our Sunday Visitor will evaluate the responses and provide an extensive analysis of the results. This will include both a written evaluation of the responses and opinions received from the study as well as a recommendation of whether or not we can realistically proceed to fulfill our vision for our parish.
