

"All things are possible for God."

An encounter with Jesus changes us forever. As the Letter to the Hebrews tells us: "Indeed the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart."

In the gospels the blind see and the paralyzed walk. Encountering Jesus has the power to make all things new. Today, a young man approaches Jesus with the question, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Mark tells us, "Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." The young man, unable to fully embrace God's divine wisdom, "went away sad, for he had many possessions."

So often things can get in the way of our following Christ. Sometimes because of material possessions. Or the fear of change or inability to trust or love. Or maybe it's the attachment to a particular sin or our own resistance to change. How hard it is to let go of what might be separating us from God's will. The *possessions* keep us from following Christ completely. We aren't sure what happened to the young man in the gospel. I want to believe that his encounter with Jesus was life changing. "All things are possible for God," Jesus tells us.


