

# **DAILY GOSPEL READINGS**

Oct. 29 - Nov. 2, 2018

Mon: Luke 13:10-17

First Reading: Jeremiah 31:7-9; Psalm 126:1-2, 2-3, 4-5, 6; Second Reading: Hebrews 5:1-6; Gospel: Mark 10:46-5

"Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you."

Our Gospel introduces us to Bartimaeus, a blind beggar on the side of the road outside Jericho. We are told that he hears that Jesus is coming. Even with the large crowd this man in need cries out, trying to get Jesus' attention. He asks Jesus' for nothing more than pity. While others attempt to quiet him, Jesus hears Bartimaeus and urges the disciples to bring him closer. They call out to him, "Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." Mark tell us that the man tosses aside his cloak—his protection—and finds Jesus. He places his trust in Jesus and no longer needs the cloak. Then Jesus asks him the important question, "What do you want me to do for you?" Bartimaeus replies, "Master, I want to see." And Jesus, with compassion, seeing his faith, tells the man, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." We are told that, "Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way." He becomes a disciple!

We, too, hear the voice, "Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." Today Jesus asks us, "What do you want me to do for you?" Do we respond with Bartimaeus? "Master, I want to see." Our love and faith, like that of Bartimaeus, calls us to follow Jesus all the way to the cross and resurrection!




