**First Reading: 1 Kings 17:10-16; Psalm 146:7, 8-9, 9-10;
Second Reading: Hebrews 9:24-28; Gospel: Mark 12:38-44**

Love: A Way of Life "Do not be afraid."

We receive this Sunday the touching and faith-filled example of two women, both widows and very poor. Both are willing to open their hands and hearts to God. They give over the little that they have, placing all their trust in God. It could not have been easy for either woman. The widow of Zarephath has only a handful of flour in her jar when she receives a visit from a stranger, Elijah the prophet. She hears his words, "Do not be afraid," and places her trust in the Lord of Life. The widow in the temple of Jerusalem, also places her trust in God. She offers all that she has—two small coins—to God. She gives over her life to God.

The hearts of the poor widows remind us of the love that Jesus asks of us. The women witness their love for God and neighbor by offering all that they have to live on to serve others. Psalm 146 tells us: "The Lord loves the just; the Lord protects strangers. The fatherless and the widow he sustains, but the way of the wicked he thwarts." Like these women of faith, may our hearts follow their loving example. "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."
