“You are my inheritance, O Lord!”

“The end is our beginning,” writes T.S. Eliot. We are not to live in fear but rather to be ready. Jesus urges us to prepare ourselves not out of fear, but with faith, hope and love. Living the gift of our lives with trust in God’s love for us calls us to recognize and accept the newness of life.

“Learn a lesson from the fig tree,” Jesus tells us. “When its branch becomes tender and sprouts leaves, you know that summer is near.” Our readings this Sunday remind us of new beginnings that await us. As we approach the end of this Church Year, like the fig tree, we are to give life to the world. We do this by bearing fruit that lasts forever. And this is our inheritance! As God’s people, followers of Jesus, we live to give life to the world by serving, caring, giving, embracing, welcoming and healing.

The Book of the Prophet Daniel calls us to a life of faithfulness. In the midst of violence and a darkened world, we bring light, joy and hope. Our inheritance may include suffering—the cross—“but the wise shall shine brightly like the splendor of the firmament, and those who lead the many to justice shall be like the stars forever.”

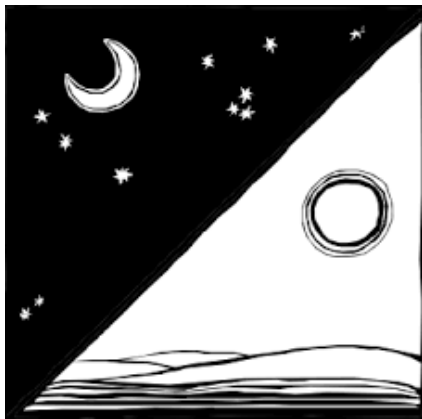
