
Our Lord Jesus Chríst, Kíng of the Uníverse November 25, 2018



DAILY GOSPEL READINGS Nov. 26-30, 2018 Mon: Luke 21:1-4 Tues: Luke 21:5-11 Wed: Luke 21:12-19 Thurs: Luke 21:20-28

First Reading: Daniel 7:13-14; Psalm 93:1, 1-2, 5; Second Reading: Revelation 1:5-8; Gospel: John 18:33b-37

"For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth."

We conclude our liturgical or Church year by proclaiming Christ as King. His truth is universal—not limited to a nation or a people—and requires of us an allegiance to the truth. A truth that Jesus lived and proclaimed here on earth and eternally with the Father. The truth of Christ the King is LOVE. A reign or kingdom of love, mercy and peace. A reign that all people are invited to enter and experience. As followers of Christ, we witness our allegiance to our Lord, the Lord of Life, by committing ourselves to live and witness the merciful and just reign of non-violence and peace. Jesus tells us, "Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

As we listen to the voice of Jesus and live humbly, with integrity and compassion, our faith in a God of love, we belong to the truth. While the reigns of the world are passing, the reign of Christ the King is eternal. How appropriate that we conclude our year of faith as the Body of Christ celebrating our allegiance to the eternal King and Reign of God. Jesus tells us: "I came into the world to testify to the truth." Nothing less is asked of us.

Capital Campaign Update

We want to thanks all of our parishioners who participated in our Capital Campaign feasibility study. Given overwhelming support (84%) to move ahead with a Capital Campaign to fund a renewal of our parish facilities, we are making plans to officially begin a Capital Campaign in early 2019.

The Site Committee and Capital Campaign Committee met on Thursday, November 15, to discuss the OSV Feasibility Study report and recommendations. As announced during our Masses last Saturday and Sunday, we believe that a \$600,000 campaign goal is realistic for our parish. We certainly do not want the parish do go into debt and promise to keep you informed as we move forward with the project. If you have any thoughts or recommendations, please speak with Fr. We are grateful to all of you who participated in our 2018 AMA for the Diocese which supports the many diverse ministries of the Diocese of Monterey. Our 2018 financial goal was \$50,000 with 110 parishioners participating. \$47,205 was actually collected with 106 parishioners participating. All pledges have been fulfilled. After meeting our \$10,500 commitment to the Diocese, \$36,705 was added to our Capital Campaign Fund.


