Last week, the diocese released a list of 30 priests who have been credibly accused of abusing children. Bishop Wilkerson said in his letter released along with the list, "This has been a painful process for all involved. Sexual misconduct with a minor is a heinous sin and crime and something that should never happen especially by a trusted person such as a priest, deacon or religious. I deeply apologize to every victim of sexual misconduct by anyone associated with the Diocese of Monterey and I extend the offer of counseling to you. 
Oremos:
