Bishop Wilkerson, Diocese of Monterey

The Diocese of Monterey released a list of priests who have been credibly accused of abusing children. Bishop Wilkerson said in his letter released along with the list, "This has been a painful process for all involved. Sexual misconduct with a minor is a heinous sin and crime and something that should never happen—especially by a trusted person such as a priest, deacon or religious. I deeply apologize to every victim of sexual misconduct by anyone associated with the Diocese of Monterey and I extend the offer of counseling to you. We, your clergy are profoundly sorry for the abuse that has occurred in the past, and we pledge to do everything in our power to prevent a single case of abuse from ever happening again.


