**“You are Christ’s body, and individually parts of it.”**

Reading from the scroll of the prophet Isaiah, Jesus clearly proclaims his mission: “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.” He continues, “Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.”

It is the Spirit of God that empowers Jesus to bring new life, healing and hope to God’s people. It is the same Spirit that accompanies us today as his body. As Paul tells us, “we were all given to drink of one Spirit.” The Spirit moves us to bring good news to the poor and to end all poverty, division, racism and violence that separates us as family of God. We share in the mission of Jesus. As disciples, let us do our part to fulfill his words in our time. As Paul tells us, “If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy.”

## Capital Campaign Update

Planning for our parish facilities update continues with the concerns of the parish community in mind. That includes reducing scope of the update to be bounded by our ability to fund the project without debt, and without selling any parish assets, including the vacant lot or rectory. Our building fund provides a substantial start to funding the update project, but our upcoming Capital Campaign will be critical to its success. The Diocese of Monterey released a list of priests who have been credibly accused of abusing children. Bishop Wilkerson said in his letter released along with the list, “This has been a painful process for all involved. Sexual misconduct with a minor is a heinous sin and crime and something that should never happen—especially by a trusted person such as a priest, deacon or religious. I deeply apologize to every victim of sexual misconduct by anyone associated with the Diocese of Monterey and I extend the offer of counseling to you.
