

"They were all filled with fury."

The prophetic Word rooted in love is very often unwelcome. For this reason, even in his hometown of Nazareth, Jesus' relationship with the Father, the God of Love, was unwelcome. He spoke clearly about breaking boundaries and barriers, taking God's saving love to all peoples.

As we gather this Sunday, we, too, like Jesus, are called in baptism to be prophetic voices for our time. We are asked by our Lord to speak the truth on behalf of others and witness God's love as the source of life and life eternal. The love of Jesus of Nazareth is a sacrificial love. This is the love that Paul presents to the early community of Corinth. It is often known as "agape," love. The highest form of love or charity.

God's Kingdom, proclaimed by Jesus, comes about as our lives are given over to God with faithfulness and courage. Like the young prophet Jeremiah, God knows us intimately. May we reflect and reveal God's love by living the prophetic dimension of our baptism—a love without limits.


