

"Put out into deep water..."

"Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." As Peter and the other fishermen learned, when we place our trust in God, unexpected, amazing things happen! Not only were there fish, but there were so many fish that their nets began to tear! Peter had to ask for men in another boat to help. Imagine that! As is often true when God is involved, there's an abundance! More wine, more loaves and fish, more love and mercy, more fish than anyone could have ever imagined!

The same is true for us. As Isaiah and Paul also experience, God works with us and calls us to the new possibilities. "Here I am, send me!" The prophet Isaiah responds with courage. And Paul, "But by the grace of God I am what I am..." Each of us is instructed to "put out into deep water." As we do so, we are reminded this Sunday, amazing things will happen! God's knows us intimately and calls us to new possibilities!


