First Reading: Deut. 26:4-10; Psalm 91: 1-2, 10-15; Second Reading: Romans 10: 8-13; Gospel: Lk 4:1-13

"The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart."

Immediately after his baptism, with the power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus was led into the desert and tempted by the devil. He remained firmly rooted and faithful to the word and authority of his Father. Evil tried to persuade him, but Jesus resisted to give comfort, wealth and power authority over him. His life was given over for the Father's will.

As followers of Jesus, baptized with the Holy Spirit, we began our Lenten journey on Ash Wednesday. Freshly marked by ashes, we recognize our sin, need for God, and ongoing conversion. We enter the desert with our Lord for these forty days of prayer, fasting and works of charity and solidarity with the poor and suffering. Like Jesus, the Father's love has authority over us. We confront all evil with God's love.

Paul tells us, "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart." Our Lord journeys with us on our Lenten journey of faith—this sacred pilgrimage of hope, healing and renewed life in Christ!

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
