Maintaining God’s House Update

We are very grateful to all of you who have made pledges or one time donations to our Capital Campaign—*Maintaining God’s House*. Your love for Our Lord, our Catholic faith, and our special parish of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is apparent and deeply appreciated.
