“Father, into your hands I commend my spirit.”

These moving words of Jesus from the cross are not words of despair, but rather confidence in God’s faithful love. These final words of Jesus are a reminder that our Crucified Lord turns to the Father who alone can rescue him. As St. Paul tells us, “He humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.”

This Holy Week is a graced opportunity to deepen our life in Christ. We, too, place our trust in our loving God who leads us to the cross of his beloved son with the promise of the resurrection. May the days ahead deepen our prayer and humble service to God’s people.

Let us pray: Father, forgive us for our indiscretions, our human weaknesses, the same weaknesses that led the throng to yell, “Crucify him.” No matter how difficult our struggles, no matter how alone or weak we may feel, you are with us. We bow our heads at Jesus’ name, knowing we are not worthy and yet are loved beyond measure.

- ✠ **Holy Thursday, Mass of the Last Supper, April 18, 7:30 pm (Bilingual)**
- ✠ **Good Friday, Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord, April 19, 3:00 pm (English) / 6:00 pm (Spanish)**
- ✠ **Holy Saturday, Vigil of the Resurrection of the Lord, April 20, 7:30 pm (English)**
- ✠ **Easter Sunday, Celebration of the Lord’s Resurrection, April 21, 9:00 am (English) and 11:15 am (Bilingual)**

May the Crucified and Risen Jesus always guide our lives. Join us this Holy Week.
