**Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41; Psalm 30:2, 4, 5-6, 11-13;
Second Reading: Revelation 5:11-14; Gospel: John 21:1-19**

“Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.”

I always find these words of Peter so very touching. Peter is asked by Jesus three times—the same number of times that he denied knowing Jesus during his passion—if he loves him. Each time he is told by the Risen Lord to care for his sheep. And then, of course, the final words of Jesus, “Follow me.”

This moving encounter between Jesus and Peter, the final resurrection story in John’s Gospel, is a beautiful reminder for us of God’s mercy and love for Peter—and for each of us. It all begins with Peter and other apostles fishing without any luck. The Risen Jesus appears and tells them to try something different, “Cast your net over the right side of the boat and you will find something.” As they listen to him, the men receive an abundance of fish. They then share in a very special breakfast. May we, too, encounter, recognize, and listen to the Risen Jesus and respond to his gift of abundant love!

Maintaining God’s House Update

The Capital Campaign continues with \$636,000 in pledges received from 84 generous donors. The parish strives to have as many of our nearly 200 registered parishioners as possible participate and every donation counts. We need you! Meanwhile the Site Committee is moving ahead with the architect into the design development phase focusing on structural issues. Soils testing should shortly be underway to understand any conditions that would seriously impact construction costs. The Site Committee’s goal is to complete the complex design and permitting process by April 2020, with construction commencing thereafter. We will continue to update the parish community biweekly. Thank you for your loving and faithful commitment to our Lord, our Church and Parish.
