"As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."

Jesus has just shared his last supper and washed the feet of his disciples. Judas has left them. Jesus knows very well what is coming. He asks his disciples, and us, to love one another as he has loved us. We are told to love unconditionally and selflessly—a sacrificial love that identifies us with the heart of Jesus and his cross. Jesus makes it very clear, "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Paul and Barnabas urge new disciples to "persevere in the faith." They tell early followers of Jesus, "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." John, too, in the Book of Revelation proclaims the Lord's ever faithful and transforming love. "He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain, for the old order has passed away." May we reveal God's love and make all things new!

Maintaining God's House Update

The Capital Campaign continues with \$656,000 in pledges received from 89 generous donors. The parish strives to have as many of our nearly 200 registered parishioners as possible participate and every donation counts. We need you! Meanwhile the Site Committee is moving ahead with the architect into the design development phase focusing on structural issues. Soils testing should shortly be underway to understand any conditions that would seriously impact construction costs. The Site Committee's goal is to complete the complex design and permitting process by April 2020, with construction commencing thereafter. We will continue to update the parish community as possible. Thank you for your loving and faithful commitment to our Lord, our Church and Parish.


