Pentecost is a day filled with immense joy, unity and hope for the Church—the Body of Christ. The coming of the Holy Spirit, the Divine Advocate, promised by Jesus, brings new life for all of us! Pentecost was originally for the Jewish people a sacred Spring grain harvest and offering of the first fruits. It was a sacred celebration of prayer and thanksgiving! A joyful reminder of God’s faithfulness, Pentecost, with people gathered from throughout the world, was a festival of unity before God!

It’s not a surprise that the Father fulfilled Jesus’ promise on this fiftieth day of Easter.
