Hospitality has always been very sacred to God's people. Abraham recognizes the Lord God visiting him in three strangers in need. He and Sarah are rewarded for their kindness toward the travelers with a son. In Matthew 25:35, Jesus tells us that when we welcome a stranger we welcome him. Hospitality to Jesus is offered by Martha and Mary in our gospel this week. We, too, are invited to serve Jesus through our lives.

Luke tells us that Martha and Mary showed their love for the Lord by welcoming him into their home. Martha generously serves Jesus and Mary attentively listens to him. According to Jesus, "Mary has chosen the better part." It's important to note that Mary is sitting in the position of a disciple, learning from her Teacher. In a time when only men were students and disciples, God's word is offered to everyone! We are all called to share his life. The greatest act of hospitality is offered by Jesus himself! He receives all of us with love. Let us follow his example.


