Labor Day weekend is a special occasion to remember and give thanks for all workers—especially those who are underappreciated. The Gospel this Sunday urges us to welcome and care for the poor and marginalized. Our sisters and brothers so often do the work that others would not even consider doing. Jesus tell us that his followers are to live generously and humbly before others—without expecting anything in return, "For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." He urges us to live humbly by reaching out, inviting and receiving those who cannot repay us. In his words, "For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

The Book of Sirach tells us that humility is a virtue to be cultivated. He tells us that this is especially true for those in high places of wealth or power. It is by living humbly and being attentive to the poor that we will "find favor with God." The Creator who is always at work!


