**First Reading: Amos 6:1a, 4-7; Psalm 146:7, 8-9, 9-10;
Second Reading: 1 Timothy 6:11-16; Gospel: Luke 16:19-31**

“Lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus.”

Lazarus is the only person given a name in the parables of Jesus. He is a very poor man and lives in front of the house of a very rich man. This man shows no interest in Lazarus. He is indifferent to his suffering and lives life with an attitude of entitlement. He sadly believes that he deserves everything he has, while Lazarus deserves his poverty. When Lazarus dies he is carried by angels to heaven, whereas the rich man, when he dies, finds himself in “the netherworld” in torment. There is “a great chasm” between the two, a chasm that the rich man’s pride and selfishness built. A chasm that sadly exists in our world today.

On this day for Migrants and Refugees we are asked to open our hearts to their suffering. Like Lazarus, they have names and are beloved children of God. May our prayers and compassion unite us to the Heart of Jesus. In His Heart we will encounter our sisters and brothers. And with Jesus, we will bridge the great chasm between the rich and poor.

World Day for Migrants and Refugees

The Vatican’s World Day for Migrants and Refugees will be held **this Sunday, September 29, 2019**. The theme for this year’s celebration is, “It is not just about migrants.” Bishop Joe S. Vásquez, Chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops’ Committee on Migration, noted: “This year’s theme for the World Day for Migrants and Refugees is an opportunity to look at the migration issue from the lens of humanity, of caring for and walking with our brothers and sisters. The World Day for Migrants and Refugees reminds us that it is not about where people come from but their unique God-given human dignity.” Bishop Vásquez noted. “It reflects our call as people of faith to welcome our brothers and sisters, promote their well-being, protect them from cruelty and human indifference, and assist in their integration into our community.”

Support for migrants and refugees is particularly vital in this moment as the world is in the midst of the greatest global forced displacement crisis on record. **As a parish, a special bilingual Holy Hour with the Blessed Sacrament will take place at 6:00 pm, in prayer for all migrants and refugees.**
