


Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

**First Reading: Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4 Psalm 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9;
Second Reading: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14; Gospel: Luke 17:5-10**

“God did not give us a spirit of cowardice.” —2 Timothy 1:7

Faith the size of a mustard seed gives us the strength and courage to respond to God’s will. As people of God—created in God’s image and likeness—life is sacred and holy. In today’s gospel, the Lord asks us to live our faith as servants—servants of God and all life. All life is sacred, beloved, and to be served and protected.

The “seamless garment” approach to a consistent ethic of life urges us to witness the gift and power of our faith. Paul’s letter to Timothy challenges us, “to stir into flame the gift of God” that we might live not “a spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control...bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God.” All life is to be honored and respected. Pope Francis tells us, “This love must be passionate, consistent and unconditional.” Let us live our faith with courage—today, this month, and always! Doing so, “we have done what we were obliged to do.”


Maintaining God’s House Update


