

It's very appropriate that our gospel this Sunday urges us to be persistent in our prayer life. Like the poor widow who is persistent with the unjust judge, we, too, should never give up! Perseverance is an especially important quality as we journey in faith. The parable of the widow asking that a just decision be made on her behalf is especially important during this Respect Life Month. We are told that the unjust judge "neither feared God or respected any human being."

As we work to care for others and protect the dignity and sacredness of all life, we often confront individuals, laws and actions that don't respect God or any human being. Nonetheless we persevere with the hope and strength of the poor widow. May our perseverance in prayer reflect the commitment of the faithful widow, Moses, and Paul in our readings. In their own way, each urges us to never give up! "Our help is from the Lord, who made heaven and earth!" Psalm 121.




