

"By your perseverance you will secure your lives."—Luke 21:19

Perseverance is a virtue at the heart of our Christian life. It is a reminder of the importance of trusting in the Lord's guidance and protection. We are never alone or forgotten. Our readings this Sunday tell us that when the time of God's judgement occurs, those who are faithful will experience the Lord's salvation. It will be a time of healing and wholeness. As the Prophet Malachi and Jesus tell us, when we live according to God's ways of mercy and justice, we have nothing to fear.

Perseverance makes all things possible! In the words of Psalm 98, "The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice." How appropriate that we celebrate next week the final Sunday of our Church Year—the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. The meaningful and solemn celebration of our Lord is followed by the hope-filled Advent Season and our humble call to prepare the way of the Lord. "Let the rivers clap their hands, the mountains shout with them for joy."

Project Update: Maintaining God's House

Good news! With the financial support of the Capital Campaign our architect has achieved approval for our planned remodel through a design review application to the County of Monterey. Our architect is currently working with engineering consultants to establish a structural design and other details necessary to submit an application for a building permit from the County by mid-December. The next step in first quarter 2020 will be construction documents with the detailed finishes and material specifications that will enable contractor bidding. Good progress!




