“Let us walk in the light of the Lord!”—Isaiah 2:5

We are gifted with this sacred season of Advent to prepare spiritually for our celebration of the Lord’s coming at Christmas. Paul tells us, “It is the hour now for you to awake from sleep.” Spiritual readiness occurs as we live more deeply our discipleship and prayerfully await the hope of God’s promises. The prophet Isaiah beautifully proclaims a new day when everything will change. All darkness, violence and evil will end! The Prince of Peace brings us the hope of new beginnings. Our work for peace and justice will experience new heights! “Come, let us climb the Lord’s mountain...They shall beat their swords into plowshares...,” Isaiah promises.

These holy days of Advent are filled with new possibilities to experience peace as we journey in faith. Everything changes when we open our hearts to God’s promises. “The Son of Man will come,” Jesus tells us. All war and violence will end. “The day is at hand...put on the armor of light,” says St. Paul. God’s reign of peace is upon us! We wait with hope!

Project Update: Maintaining God’s House

With the financial support of the Capital Campaign our architect has achieved approval for our planned remodel through a design review application to the County of Monterey. Our architect is currently working with engineering consultants to establish a structural design and other details necessary to submit an application for a building permit from the County by mid-December. The next step in first quarter 2020 will be construction documents with the detailed finishes and material specifications that will enable contractor bidding.
