"Justice shall flourish in his time and fullness of peace forever." Ps. 72

First Reading: Isaiah 11:1-10; Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 12-13, 17;

Two prophets this Sunday—Isaiah and John the Baptist—shout out to us. Isaiah proclaims God's peaceable kingdom. His beautiful vision of a world transformed by the Spirit of the Lord brings about the hope and promise of justice, peace and unity among all peoples and for all of creation. The prophet of God reminds us that the coming of the Lord will bring about the fulfillment of God's presence: "Then the wolf shall be a guest of the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; the calf and the young lion shall browse together, with a little child to guide them."

John the Baptist "prepares the way of the Lord" by calling us to "repentance." The Greek word *metanoia* describes a change of mind and heart. Even today, John calls out to each of us to "produce good fruit as evidence" of our repentance. Good works that reveal the Lord's Spirit! May this Second Week of Advent renew our hearts and minds. Let us reveal God's vision and dream of peace, justice and healing for all!

Project Update: Maintaining God's House

With the financial support of the Capital Campaign our architect has achieved approval for our planned remodel through a design review application to the County of Monterey. Our architect is currently working with engineering consultants to establish a structural design and other details necessary to submit an application for a building permit from the County by mid-December. The next step in first quarter 2020 will be construction documents with the detailed finishes and material specifications that will enable contractor bidding.


