Three foreigners, outsiders, the unexpected from afar see a brilliant star breaking into the darkness of the night. The three kings or magi quickly begin their journey from the East. They find the baby Jesus not in Herod’s palace, but in a stable of animals in the loving arms of his young mother Mary. They humbly prostrate themselves before this unexpected infant. They offer him homage as if they knew that he would one day be the servant king of God’s Kingdom—the eternal reign of heaven and earth! The reign of love, mercy and peace! The travelers from afar present this tiny Emmanuel, God-with-us, treasured gifts meant for an earthly king. Project Update: Maintaining God’s House

With the financial support of the Capital Campaign, completed plans and specifications were submitted on December 13 by our architect for the improvement and upgrades, including ADA requirements, the parish hall and kitchen, bathrooms, entrance vestibule, and potential social outreach building. The Site Committee expects the County of Monterey process of issuance of a building permit to take 3 to 4 months. The Site and Capital Campaign Committees will use this time to review and develop cost cutting options should it be necessary to remain within the goal of a debt free project.

Human Trafficking Awareness Month

January is Human Trafficking Awareness Month. Our parish is committed to helping human trafficking survivors by supporting community organizations in their efforts. An important part of this ministry is educating our parish community on the real and present danger of young people being trapped in the human sex and/or labor trafficking industry here on the Monterey Peninsula.

Human Trafficking 101, an introductory training, will be offered here at OLMC on **Thursday, January 23, from 10 am to 12 Noon**. Emanuel Santillan, YWCA Outreach Specialist will be with us for the training. He will present the scope of human trafficking, its reach into our “paradise-like” back yard, and what is done locally to combat the horrific business, and care for the survivors. If you are interested in attending the workshop, a sign up sheet is located at the entrance of the church. The more we know, the more we can help others, and especially organizations such as the YWCA, the Monterey Rape Crisis Center, and the DA’s office fight human trafficking.
