The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord January 12, 2020



DAILY GOSPEL READINGS THIS WEEK

"He shall bring forth justice to the nations."—Isaiah 42:1

On this final day of the Christmas Season, our readings look to the ministry by which God is revealed through Jesus. As baptized we, too, are called to reveal and glorify God through our lives of service. We remember the words from heaven, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." God's words are meant for all of us to hear and witness. As Psalm 29 beautifully promises, "The Lord will bless his people with peace."

As we yearn for peace today, in the Middle East and throughout the world, we recall the words of Pope Paul VI, "If you want peace, work for justice." It's very appropriate that Isaiah proclaims, "Here is my servant whom I uphold, my chosen one with whom I am pleased, upon whom I have put my spirit; he shall bring forth justice to the nations..." God urges us to manifest the life and ministry of Jesus as servants and peacemakers. He is present and active through the witness of our lives. Emmanuel, God-with-us, empowers us to work for peace by acts of mercy and justice.

Project Update: Maintaining God's House

With the financial support of the Capital Campaign, completed plans and specifications were submitted on December 13 by our architect for the improvement and upgrades, including ADA requirements, the parish hall and kitchen, bathrooms, entrance vestibule, and potential social outreach building. The Site Committee expects the County of Monterey process of issuance of a building permit to take 3 to 4 months. The Site and Capital Campaign Committees will use this time to review and develop cost cutting options should it be necessary to remain within the goal of a debt free project.

Human Trafficking Awareness Month

A special training will be offered here at OLMC on Thursday, January 23, from 10 am to 12 Noon. Emanuel Santillan, YWCA Outreach Specialist will be with us. He will present the scope of human trafficking, its reach into our "paradise-like" back yard, and what is being done locally to combat the horrific business, and care for the survivors. If you are interested in attending, a sign up sheet is located at the entrance of the church. The more we know, the more we can help to stop trafficking.


