**“Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.”**

We celebrate this Monday the life of Martin Luther King, Jr., who brought light into the darkness of racial segregation and discrimination. While sitting in a jail cell in 1963, he wrote, “Darkness cannot drive out darkness; only light can do that. Hate cannot drive out hate; only love can do that.” May we always remember our prophetic call, “I will make you a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.”

Our journey through Ordinary Time begins with a reminder of the mission and ministry of Jesus, the Lamb of God. John the Baptist’s faithful testimony to Jesus, and our testimony today, manifests the Lord’s merciful presence to our world. As baptized, we follow our Teacher by freeing others from the evil and darkness that separate us from God’s love. The radical service of Jesus reflects the “beloved community” of faith and justice. The community that witnesses and builds God’s Reign here on earth and reveals the sacrifice of the lamb, nonviolence and equality among all people.

## Project Update: Maintaining God’s House

With the financial support of the Capital Campaign, completed plans and specifications were submitted on December 13 by our architect for the improvement and upgrades, including ADA requirements, the parish hall and kitchen, bathrooms, entrance vestibule, and potential social outreach building. The Site Committee expects the County of Monterey process of issuance of a building permit to take 3 to 4 months. The Site and Capital Campaign Committees will use this time to review and develop cost cutting options should it be necessary to remain within the goal of a debt free project.

## Human Trafficking Awareness Month

A special training will be offered here at OLMC this **Thursday, January 23, from 10 am to 12 Noon.** Emanuel Santillan, YWCA Outreach Specialist will be with us. He will present the scope of human trafficking, its reach into our “paradise-like” backyard, and what is being done locally to combat the horrific business, and care for the survivors. If you are interested in attending, a sign up sheet is located at the entrance of the church. The more we know, the more we can help to stop trafficking.

## National Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children, January 22, 2020

“As the Church and growing numbers of pro-life Americans continue to advocate for women and children in courthouses and legislatures, the Church’s pastoral response is focused on the needs of women facing pregnancies in challenging circumstances...The pastoral response will soon intensify.

The Committee on Pro-Life Activities at the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops is asking...parishes in their dioceses to join a nationwide effort from March 25, 2020 through March 25, 2021 entitled, “*Walking with Moms in Need: A Year of Service.*”

Recognizing that women in need can be most effectively reached at the local level, the “*Year of Service*” invites parishes to assess, communicate and expand resources to expectant mothers within their own communities. The U.S. Bishops will be providing resources, outreach tools, and models to assist parishes in this important effort. We pray that “*Walking with Moms in Need: A Year of Service*” will help us reach every pregnant mother in need, that she may know she can turn to her local Catholic community for help and authentic friendship.” —**Archbishop Joseph F. 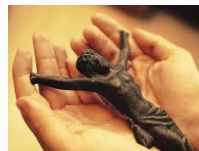
