“They left their nets and followed him.” —Matthew 4:20

With John the Baptist being arrested, Jesus now begins his public ministry of bringing good news of hope, healing and new life to those who live in darkness and fear. The Son of God proclaims repentance and new life, “for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.” As Isaiah tells us, “The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light.” And as Psalm 27 proclaims, “The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear?”

Jesus calls two brothers, Simon and Andrew—fishermen. He urges them, “Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.” Nothing holds them back. They leave their nets behind. Soon Jesus sees two more brothers, James and John, and calls them. “Immediately they left their boats and their father and followed him.” They leave what is familiar. What is secure. Discipleship calls us to do the same. Fear no longer has power over us. We place our trust in the word of the Lord. He empowers us with his love to build the kingdom of joy, hope and new life! Everything changes!

Project Update: Maintaining God’s House

1/17/20: The set of building plans submitted to Monterey County in December are under review by six separate county departments. Our architect is communicating regularly with each department to ensure good communication and a quick response to any questions. We are still hoping to receive approval this spring.

Our Capital Campaign continues to progress with 99 pledges totaling \$632,615 through mid-January, and total donations (pledge and non-pledge) totaling \$685,891.
