DAILY GOSPEL READINGS THIS WEEK

First Reading: Malachi 3:1-4; Psalm 24:7-10; Second Reading: Hebrews 2:14-18; Gospel: Luke 2:22-40

"Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace." -Luke 2:29

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord falls this year on a Sunday. We celebrate the special day remembering the humility of our saving God. Luke tells us that Jesus, in Mary's arms, enters the Temple with Joseph. Those in the Temple see the simple couple carrying two turtledoves, the offering of the poor. Two servants and prophetic voices in the Temple, Simeon and Anna, see much more however. The Holy Spirit is with them and they recognize and proclaim the baby Jesus as the salvation of God's people. Filled with deep faith and love they welcome the child with joy.

This meaningful day reminds us of the importance of the witness of our faith. Like Simeon and Anna, we, too, persevere with hope and faith. Only then will we recognize the Lord in the poor, the migrant and refugee, the prisoner, and the homeless. His light will burn within us as we recognize him among us. And like Simeon, we can proclaim, "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace...for my eyes have seen your salvation."

Project Update: Maintaining God's House

The set of building plans submitted to Monterey County in December are under review by six separate county departments. Our architect is communicating regularly with each department to ensure good communication and a quick response to any questions. We are still hoping to receive approval this spring.

Our Capital Campaign continues to progress with 99 pledges totaling \$632,615 through mid-January, and total donations (pledge and non-pledge) totaling \$685,891. 
